Race 1, malfunction of gate as #1 horse, My Two Aunt Joans, K. Johnson, after being set in the gate, the stall doors opened and bell rang prior to the starter releasing field, #1 broke from the gate but was quickly pulled up by Johnson and reloaded without incident.

Spoke with Starter Mark Penford was not sure what had happened, they did a recheck of the gate following the race, everything appeared to be functioning properly.

#2 Redoute's Light broke slow and trailed the field throughout. Rest ok.

Race 2, #4 Rifling, K. Johson, 2<sup>nd</sup>, a little fractious prior to the start. Off a step slow, rest ok.

Race 3, Off turf, #4 Bill Needle, C. Husbands, 3<sup>rd</sup>. off a step slow, #5 Rescue That Girl, A Sanchez, 5<sup>th</sup>, stumbled start. Rest good.
