Race 2, #3, Moral Turptitude, I Mosqueira, 3rd, bore out at start to the hind end of #4. Rest good

Race 3, Stewards' Inquiry and Jockey claim of foul, #5 Shako, E. Zenteno, 1st, and #2 Frac City, J. Crawford, 2nd. Inside the 1/16th. Upon review of the upper pan and front tower camera angles, #5 outside does take a step in and the #3 Sweeping Red, C. Husbands, 3rd, inside, takes a step out as they move past the 1/16th pole. It was determined #3 makes initial contact from the inside pushed #2 out to #5, this is more evident in the slow-motion mode. #5 is not the major contributor

to the interference and the claim of foul was disallowed and no changes made to the order by the Stewards. Rest ok.
